The historic National Physical Laboratory (NPL) is the National Measurements Institute for the United Kingdom and an ideal place to host MUST 2021. With decades of experience in ultrasound research, NPL develops cutting-edge ultrasound metrology that address measurement challenges provided by emerging medical ultrasound technologies.

Location

NPL is based in Teddington, London, England and is easy to get to. For international attendees traveling by air, NPL is just 6 miles (approximately 20 minute drive) from the well-connected London Heathrow Airport. For UK attendees, NPL is 0.5 miles from Teddington Train Station with trains to and from London Waterloo Train Station every 15 minutes.

Venue

The NPL has excellent conferencing and hospitality facilities and regularly hosts conferences and workshops. The main lecture theatre accommodates up to 130 people with a large projector screen and microphone system. A reception area is used for breaks, lunch and hosting poster sessions. Posters can be presented on boards or electronically displayed on 12 large totem screens. Large meeting rooms directly adjacent to the lecture theatre are ideal for hosting conference exhibits.

Conference social events are hosted on the NPL site in the historic Bushy House, built in 1714 and later where NPL was established in 1900. Additionally, there are a number of suitable local venues for evening events, for example Hampton Court Palace, The Wharf restaurant and Brooklands Museum.
